



EDUCATION AGREEMENT 2020/2021

In consideration of Budapest British International SCHOOL (the "School") accepting the Student (the "Student") at the School, Parent(s)/Guardian(s) of the Student do hereby jointly agree to undertake with the School as follows:

1. Attendance

Unless prevented by sickness or other reason satisfactory to the School, the Student will regularly attend the School and strictly comply with the Terms and Conditions, the rules and regulations of the School policies and any other internal documents provided by the School, as well as the dates and deadlines set forth in the School calendar of the School.

2. Parents obligations

We (the Parents/Guardians) will conform to the rules and regulations of the School. We will respect the School's mission statement and support the Student in doing so. We undertake to update ourselves on school policy updates through the school website, and understand that the school will send them notifications about these. Our communication with staff, fellow parents and students of the School will be polite and respectful.

We will use established procedures to raise concerns.

3. Student safety

We (the Parents/Guardians) agree to notify the School at the time of any illness, accident, medical condition, (whether under treatment or not), or any other circumstances (such as bereavement), which might affect the physical or mental performance of the Student. When driving and parking in the School grounds we will respect the rules of the School and requests of the supervisory staff. The school undertakes to follow all required health and safety requirements and safeguarding guidelines.

4. Student's health

4.1 We (the Parents/Guardians) declare, that we have disclosed the relevant medical data about the Student in the Student Medical Form provided by the School and this will be held on the school's GDPR compliant management information system, and we will keep the School informed of any changes to the information provided therein.

4.2 In the event of an accident, or serious illness of the Student, and should the school be unable to contact us (the parents/guardians), we authorize the Principal or their authorized representatives to seek medical treatment for the Student, at his/her complete discretion, and I/we agree to pay all medical fees in this respect.



5. Participation in activities organized by the School

5.1 We (the Parents/Guardians) agree to allow the Student to participate in all of the School's activities and competitions, trips and other forms of physical activities organized by the School.

If any of these activities involves excursions outside the School, I/we agree that prior notification by the School will be sufficient.

I/we will take note of any equipment and/or clothing that the Student may need for excursions outside of the School, and the transport arrangements for the activity. I/we understand the school undertakes rigorous risk assessments in the planning of any trip or excursion.

5.2 In consenting to the above, I/we acknowledge that participation in sports activities and competitions, trips and other forms of activity have a natural risk element and I/we are aware of that risk, but that the school takes all precautions during the risk assessment process.

5.3 During excursions outside of the School, I/we understand the need for the Student to behave responsibly and follow the normal school rules and adult supervision instructions.

5.4 I/we give my/our permission for the Student to be taken on school trips to the local area, and further away for school journeys, as part of the curriculum during school time.

5.5 If necessary whilst participating in any trip or excursion, I/we also, consent to the Student receiving first aid care (including the administration of mild pain-relieving medicine for things such as headaches e.g. ibuprofen), as considered necessary by the person responsible for first aid on the trip or excursion. I/we will notify the school of any medication allergies.

5.6. In extreme circumstances, I/we consent to the Student receiving any necessary emergency medical treatment as advised/administered by a medical professional. In such an event I understand that the School will notify the emergency contact listed on the Student's Medical Form immediately.

5.7 I/we will inform the School in writing about any disabilities or illnesses of the Student regarding his/her ability to participate in sports activities and competitions, trips and other forms of physical activities organized by the School.

5.8 That I/we give permission for the Budapest British International School to use any photographs/filming materials of the Student in marketing and communication and other relevant publicity materials related to the School, and its operations, including, but not limited to, websites, brochures and other marketing materials, annual reports, and yearbooks.

This permission can be withdrawn in writing at any point.



6. Care for the Student

6.1 The School shall be liable for the health and safety of the Student to the extent stipulated by the applicable laws of Hungary, and the international standards of safeguarding and child protection as outlined by COBIS.

6.2 Any change of my/our address, phone number, email or any other relevant contact, should be immediately notified to the School in writing via email or written note. Any change in the persons authorized to collect the Student should be immediately notified to the School in writing. In case of such notification failure, the School will not be liable for:

- a) Consequences of the failure to inform you about accidents or the Student willfully leaving the School;
- b) Failure to deliver correspondence to Parents/Guardians; in such case correspondence shall be deemed to be delivered after it is sent to the address known to the School; or
- c) Handing over a Student to a person not authorized to collect him/her.

6.4 Any changes to the Student's particulars shall be advised in writing as soon as possible to the School Office via email office@bbis.hu.

6.5 If any matter requires the approval or notification of the Parents/Guardians, it will be sufficient for the School to notify or obtain approval from one parent/Guardian.

7. Right to assign

The School may assign or transfer this Agreement or any or all of its rights and/or obligations under it to any associated company of the School.

The Parents/Guardians declare, that they have read and fully understand this Education Agreement and agree to be bound by it and any documents referred to in it, as well as by any subsequent amendment as notified from time to time by the School.

8. Registration

The Parents/Guardians hereby acknowledge, that seat reservation for the next academic year is required to be paid by the first day of Term 3.

9. Withdrawal

At any time, a period of one term's notice is required, this must be made in writing to the Principal, for the withdrawal of a Student.

Failure to provide one term's notice will result in the contribution for the following term being payable, minus the deposit of HUF 200,000 and the seat reservation of HUF 500.000. In the event that the contribution has already been paid, then only the deposit



of 200,000 HUF will be returned. Notice must be given in writing on the first day of the term prior to leaving.

10. Terms and Conditions

10.1 By signing this Education Agreement, we (the Parents/Guardians) declare that the School has made available the Terms and Conditions for perusal. We (the Parents/Guardians) declare that we have read and understood the Terms and Conditions, and we accept these terms. The Terms and Conditions shall become part of this Education Agreement.

10.2 We (the Parents/Guardians) hereby acknowledge, that the School is entitled to modify the Terms and Conditions – and other relevant internal documents - unilaterally from time to time by informing the Parents/Guardians about the new or modified terms, by the way of posting the new and/or modified terms to the School's website (www.bbis.hu).

10.3. The amendment or the new provision of the Terms and Conditions will take effect when the School notifies the Parents/Guardians in writing. The written notification will be sent to the e-mail address given by the Parents/Guardians. It is sufficient if the written notification contains a reference or a link to the website of the School.

10.4. If a provision of the Terms and Conditions and another condition of this agreement differ from one another, the latter shall be integrated into the contract.

11. Come into force

Present Education Agreement comes into force by acceptance of the offer sent by the School. The offer may be accepted by sending a reply e-mail to the address from which the offer was received. Any wording such as "I confirm", "I accept" or any similar with the same meaning shall be considered as the acceptance of the offer. Acceptance of the offer also means the acceptance of the provisions of present Education Agreement as binding.

12. Governing law

Issues not covered by this contract are governed by the provisions of the Civil Code of Hungary.
