## Secondary EAL Provision 2024/25

At BBIS, our programme of English as an Additional Language (EAL) teaching is a key feature of welcoming an increasingly diverse, international community to the school. Our EAL programme is organised by qualified teachers who support students where English is not their first language, by providing an intensive, targeted program.

As part of the Secondary EAL programme, each student is assessed on entry, and it is identified if EAL support is required. Since all subjects at BBIS are taught in English, a student with low levels of English would find it beneficial to spend time improving their English before they embark on analysing English Language and Literature or learn a new language like German or Spanish. Focusing on English would allow them time to build their confidence and be introduced to the challenges when they are ready. Therefore, EAL lessons take place parallel to MYP/DP Language and Literature and MYP Language Acquisition lesson periods. This means an EAL student does not attend Language and Literature and/or Language acquisition lessons. In case of exceptional needs, further EAL hours may be added instead of or in addition to mainstream subjects.

Generally, a full-time EAL student attends 10 hours of EAL lessons over 2 weeks. Students receive intensive language instruction and weekly support with subject assignments. The amount of support an EAL student receives may be reduced based on progress achieved. This progress is assessed termly.
